It is pleasing to note that the new membership list is increasing again slowly, and we do urge all members to do their utmost to keep the number advancing.

We are indebted to "Caeculus" for the exhaustive studies on the ½d and ld stamps in the last two issues and to Mr R. J. Lawrence for intensive cooperation which must have been necessary considering the number of miles which separate them! It has been suggested to me that the use of nom-de-plumes does not make for co-operation between members, particularly those overseas and in this country. ## CYLINDER FLAWS OF 1d - PLATE VIII

The appended list of flaws was compiled jointly by Mr R. J. Lawrence and the writer - and we had a lot of fun doing it!

Some fifty odd flaws have not been illustrated. They are either very tiny and serve merely for confirmation in cases of doubt, or are the tiny black dots found in the frame or margin of which there are an appreciable number.

These dots are most absent in the early printings which may be recognised by a deep black or jet black centre with generally but not always, an inverted watermark.

N.B. I have underlined those flaws which I consider worthy of inclusion in the album whilst a small cross appears in front of those flaws not illustrated on the accompanying sketches.





# "LONDON, 1960"

In all, there were six frames of Union Issues on show, from the collections of Mr E. S. C. Lauder, Glasgow, Mr T. B. Berry of Johannesburg, Mr Geo. Feros of East London, and Dr G. Ward, of Sevenoaks. However, Union Collectors found interest in the Air Mail section which provided several interesting items apertaining to Union Philately and Postal History.

The two frames contributed by Mr Lauder comprised of the material shown at Unipex, supplemented with other items, and gained a Bronze medal.

The following were the outstanding items on show, Union Commem 1910 - Two examples used in Natal on the first day. Strips and singles in various colours of the Mackay Essays. Coloured Die Proofs of the first definitives, and "Specimen" overprints. The 1d and 2d values without watermark, and the 5/- value with half moon variety. Soldiers letters bearing G.B. stamps. The official Souvenir Card for the first Air Mails and the 9d value with "strut" variety and imperf. margin. Second Air Mail -plate proofs in five colours ranging from Orange to Red. The Harrison Essays (1d's) and the rare 1d, 3d & 4d essays in three colours. Pretoria booklets ½d and 1d values tete-beche and 1d missing centre. Various examples of the 2d London definitive. The 1d ship with twisted ship variety. The 6d Orange tree colour trials, including a speculative used pair on entire. Various examples of the 10/- London printing. Examples of the unofficial Booysen and Kruger essays, together with the "Hunter Penrose" labels, and various varieties of Postage Dues and Officials.

The salient items of the two frames entered by Dr T. B. Berry of Johannesburg were as follows, and although containing some of the items already mentioned above, were none the less of great interest and gained a Silver-Gilt award.

A signed photo of the Wilkinson Essay, together with die proof in black and specimen of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ d Union Commem. Further Mackay essays, mainly in strips of five. Colour plate proofs of the De La Rue Georgians. Head/ Vignette Die Proofs of the De La Rue's, and the issued stamps. The ld ship Plates 1 & 2 and the 1926 triangular 4d showing Specimen Colour trials. Colour Trials of the London Definitives, together with imprint pairs of all values. Varieties of the Pretoria  $\frac{1}{2}$ d, 1d and 6d definitives. Rotogravure  $\frac{1}{2}$ d hyphenated -  $\frac{1}{4}$  sheet of Plate VIII and Plate XV (Cross Hatch),  $1\frac{1}{2}$ d small gold mine - coarse screen. 1926 Booklets and Roto Coils with parts of six columns plated. Among the modern were examples of the 4d Animal stamp, with partially printed frame.

# London, 1960, continued

The one frame shown by Mr Geo. Feros of East London gained a silver award and included a number of out of the way items.

These included examples of the T.P.O's mainly on the De La Rue Georgians. Examples of the Muizenberg First Flights. The Original Drawing by H. S. Wilkinson for the Union Commem. of 1910, together with Specimens of the issued stamp. The first definitives were represented by Die Proofs, Colour Trials and Specimen overprints, and examples of the £l values. The ld value with no watermark and the  $l\frac{1}{2}$ d value with watermark sideways and a block of 32  $l\frac{1}{2}$ d's showing repaired paper - before printing and perforating.

Dr G. Ward's frame, which gained a bronze award, comprised of a well known study of the  $\frac{1}{2}$ d Springbok stamps setting out examples of the seven main groups with the development in more detail of the various characteristics of these groups, showing both multipositive and cylinder flaws. The frame also included examples of the 1937 and 1948 Razor Blade Booklets, and the monocoloured coils. The 16 sheets were insufficient to do real justice to the extensive study of the  $\frac{1}{2}$ d stamp, now so very well known to Union collectors throughout the world.
